3. What are the CML hours of operation?	CML is open 24 hours/day, from 7:00 a.m. Monday until 7:00 a.m. on Saturday Saturday & Sunday – contact (402) 280.4382
4. Will the two daily CML courier runs continue?	CML will continue the two daily scheduled specimen pick-ups late morning and late afternoon. Your current schedule will remain unchanged.
5. How do we get specimens to CML in addition to the routine daily courier runs?	Specimens with completed requisitions can be dropped off at the CUMC lab located on the first floor, Monday-Friday 7:00am-7:00pm. CML couriers will deliver specimens to the CML lab. On weekends and holidays, call (402) 280.4382.

<p>6. Can specimens for CML be tubed down to the CUMC lab?</p>	<p>Specimens can continue to be tubed down to the CUMC lab. Specimens will be couriered to the CML lab.</p>
<p>7. Will the relocation of the lab cause delays in report and supply delivery?</p>	<p>The relocation of the lab will have no effect on the delivery of test reports or supplies. If you do experience a disruption in service, please contact Client Services immediately, at (402) 280.4382.</p>
<p>8. What tests currently done by CUMC will CML send out?</p>	<p>The three tests previously performed by CUMC that CML will send out are: 1) Quad Screens, including Inhibin A (for 2 months only) 2) DRVVT and 3) Low Molecular Weight Heparin Assay.</p>
<p>9. What are the differences in methodology/instrumentation and correlation statistics between CUMC and CML?</p>	<p>Immunoassay and Hematology methodology and instrumentation will remain unchanged. CML is using the Beckman Coulter for Chemistry analysis. Dr. Allen and Dr. Baltaro will be available to discuss correlation statistics for specific tests and can be reached at 280.4382.</p>
<p>10. Will CML honor current quotes?</p>	<p>CML will honor current test quotes.</p>
<p>11. Will all research accounts receive copies of CML's CAP and CLIA certificates?</p>	<p>Copies of CML's CAP and CLIA certificates are available upon request. Call 280.4382.</p>
<p>12. Where will the Quest pick-up area be located?</p>	<p>The Quest pick-up area will remain at the CUMC Send Out bench.</p>

When we publish our data, we are required to list that information.</p>	<p>The CML website is being updated to include this information.
